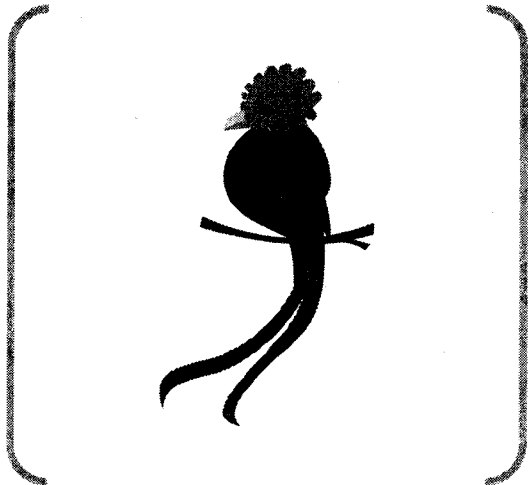


# Spanish Program
